Swing** the one your chasin' **promenade** her tonight How was I gonna get an education, sittin' right in back of Bobbie Ann Mason.

## **CLOSER:**

**Four boys promenade** one time around. **Swing. Circle left, allemande left and Weave.** Bobbie Ann Mason, back in high school, she was way too cute, she was way too cool. How was I gonna get an education, sittin' right in back of Bobbie Ann Mason.

## **TAG:**

Sittin' right in' back of Bobbie Ann Mason.
